RULES AND GUIDELINES

- VENDOR MUST OBTAIN A PERMIT FROM THE CITY OF UNION CITY (THERE IS NO CHARGE)
- EACH VENDOR IS ALLOWED A 10X10 SPACE FOR SETUP
- VENDOR WILL NOT SELL PRODUCE BEFORE DESIGNATED TIMES (7:00AM ON SATURDAYS; 2:00PM TUES/THURS)
- NO CANNED GOODS OR BREAD ARE ABLE TO BE SOLD UNLESS PROPERLY LABELED ACCORDING TO HEALTH REGULATIONS
- VENDOR FEES ARE \$3/DAY FOR PRODUCE GROWN BY VENDOR AND \$5/DAY BY PRODUCE NOT GROWN BY VENDOR. PAYMENTS MUST BE GIVEN TO LAUREN TANNER IN THE CHAMBER BUILDING EACH DAY OF SETUP.
- EACH VENDOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP THEIR 10X10 SPACE.
- EACH VENDOR MUST FOLLOW THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FARMERS MARKET STATE COMPLIANCE GUIDE.
